Secure the Scene

- Stay Calm and assess the situation.
 - **Turn off your vehicle, turn your flashers on, and place out warning devices.** Wear a high-visibility vest and make sure it is safe before you exist your vehicle.



4 DO NOT'S

- 1. **DO NOT** leave the scene without exchanging
- information with the parties involved in the incident.
- 2. **DO NOT** post on social media about the incident or any other party involved.
- 3. **DO NOT** admit fault or offer to compensate anyone involved.
- 4. **DO NOT** discuss the accident with anyone other than company management, law enforcement, or your company's insurance.

Notify Authorities (Do NOT Admit Fault)

- **Call 911** from the accident scene. Inform them where the accident occurred, if anyone was hurt, and what happened. **Remember do <u>NOT</u> admit Fault.**
- Contact your manager or supervisor as soon as possible to report the accident.

Document the Accident

- Take photos and/or video of the scene. Make sure to include all vehicles involved, including licenses
 - plates and insurance cards of the other drivers involved.
 - Get as much information as possible:
 - Year, Make, Model, Color of the involved vehicles.
 - Name, Addresses and Phone Numbers of the vehicle owner, driver at the time of the incident, and passengers in the vehicles.
 - Vehicle's insurance carrier(s) Company Name and Policy Number
 - Witnesses (Name, Phone Number, and Address)
 - Copy of the exchange information with the officer's name and case number.

Follow Post-Accident Regulations

- - Follow the company's drug and alcohol testing procedures.
